ANTI-HARASSMENT RESOURCES

Harassment (sexual or otherwise) awareness training should be conducted for employers/employees/union members/apprentices. Awareness training should be made available to new members and apprentices/new employees as soon as is practicable upon there being enrolled/employed. Training needs to be reiterated and reemphasized at regular intervals
